Leticia Morales holds a PhD in Law and a Master in Political Philosophy. She was a Postdoctoral Fellow at the McGill Institute for Health and Social Policy and the Faculty of Law, McGill University (2013-2015) and taught at the Sussex Law School (UK) in 2016. Currently, she is an associate researcher at Universidad Nacional de Mar del Plata, Argentina. She has held visiting positions at the University of Genova, the University of Edinburgh, the McGill Centre for Human Rights and Legal Pluralism in Montreal, the Hastings Center for Bioethics and Public Policy and the Interdisciplinary Center for Bioethics at Yale University. Her research focuses on the constitutional protection of social and economic rights. Leticia published a monograph, *Derechos sociales constitucionales y democracia* (Ed. Marcial Pons, 2015), and several articles arguing for a democratic approach to the justification of social and economic rights. She has published on the legal aspects of basic income proposal and is currently preparing an article examining the democratic case for basic income.
